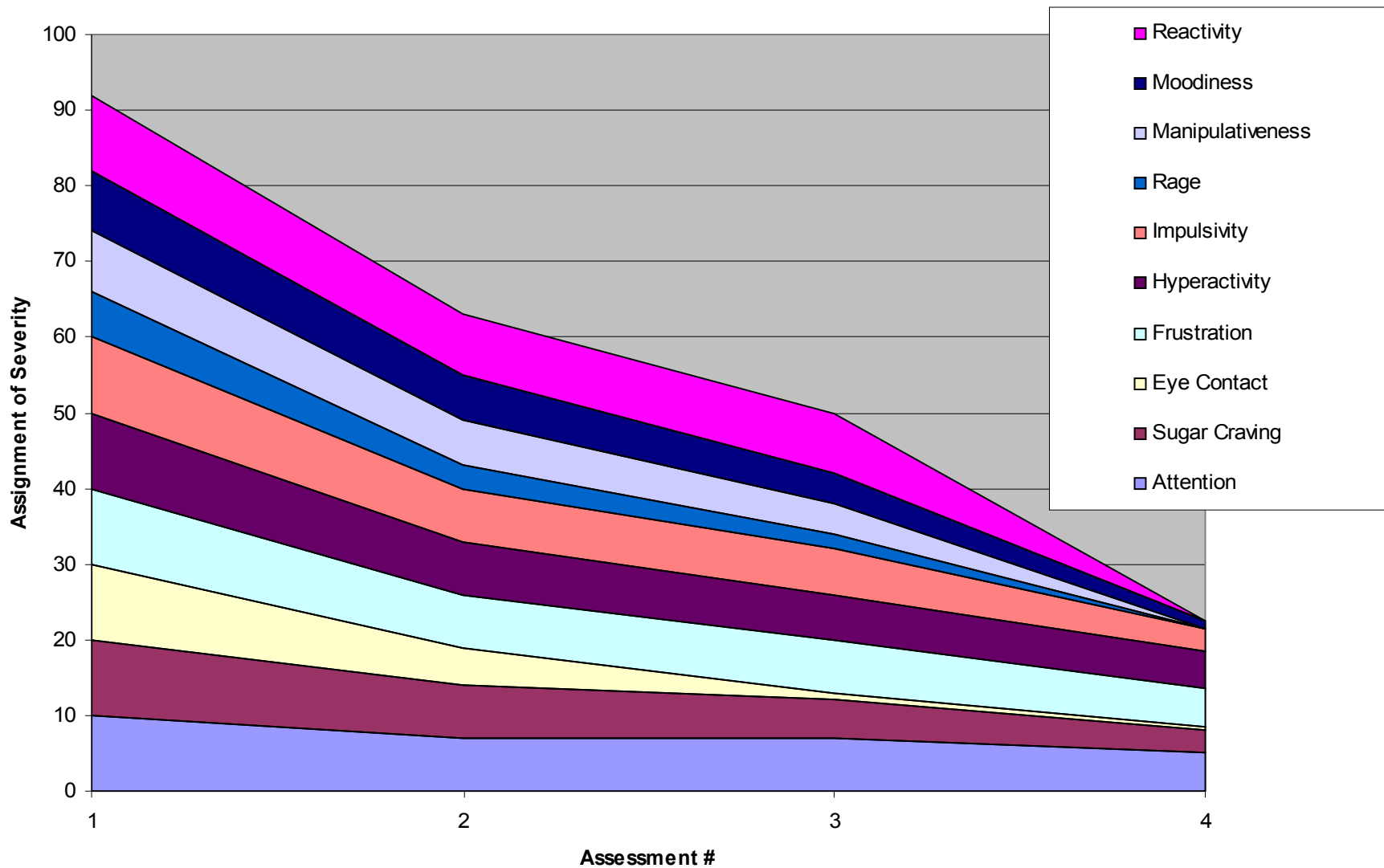
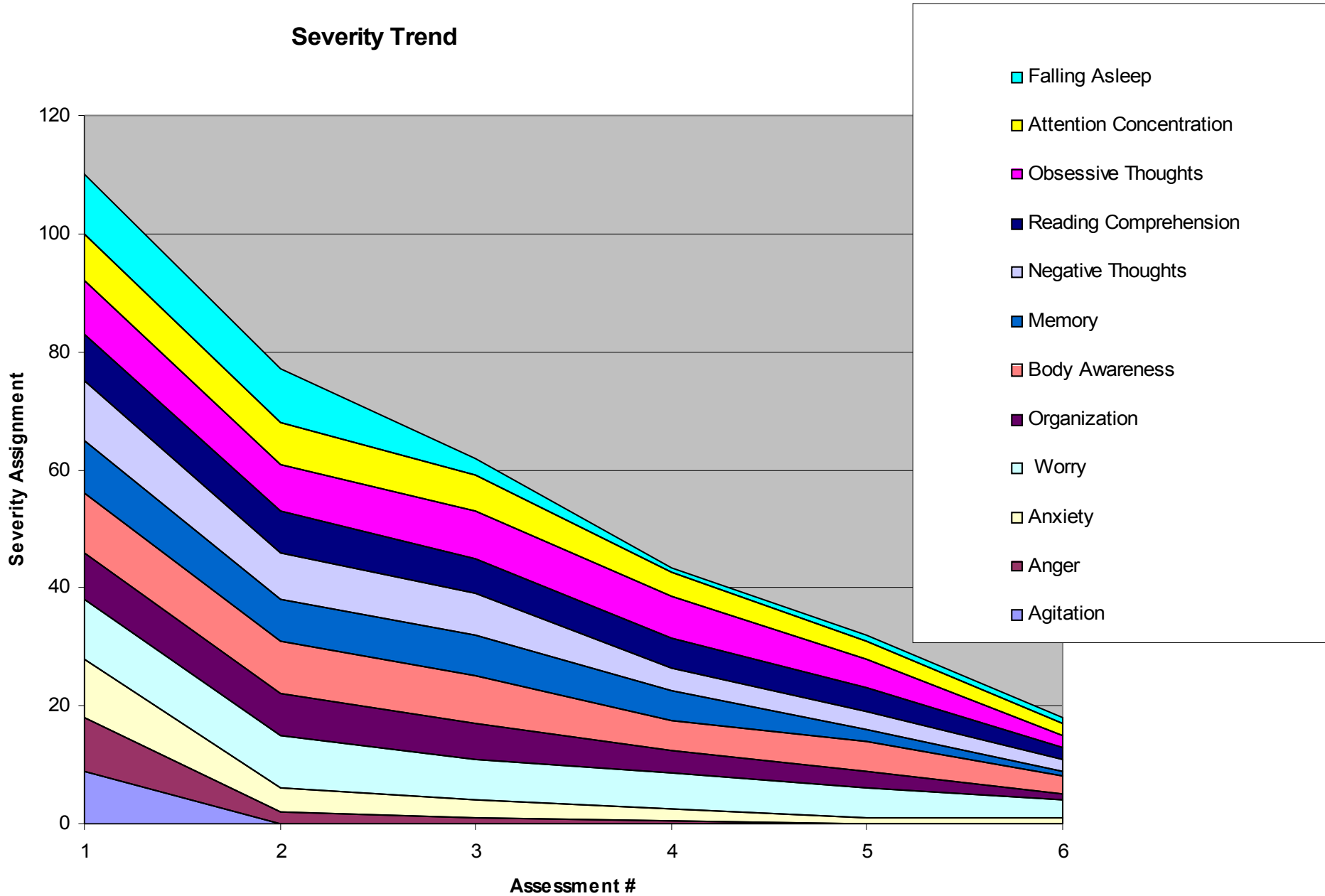

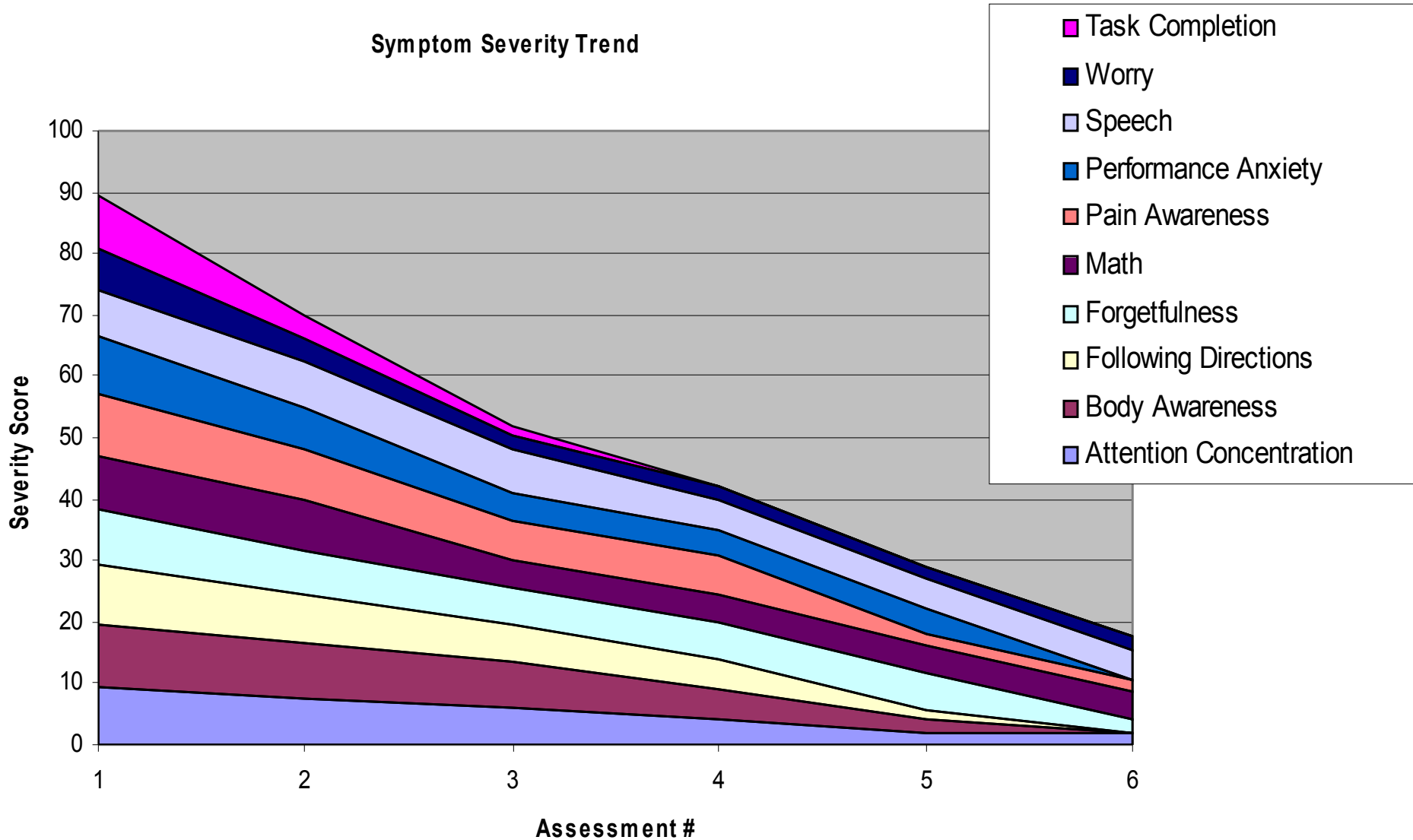


Symptom Severity Trend, Adult
